



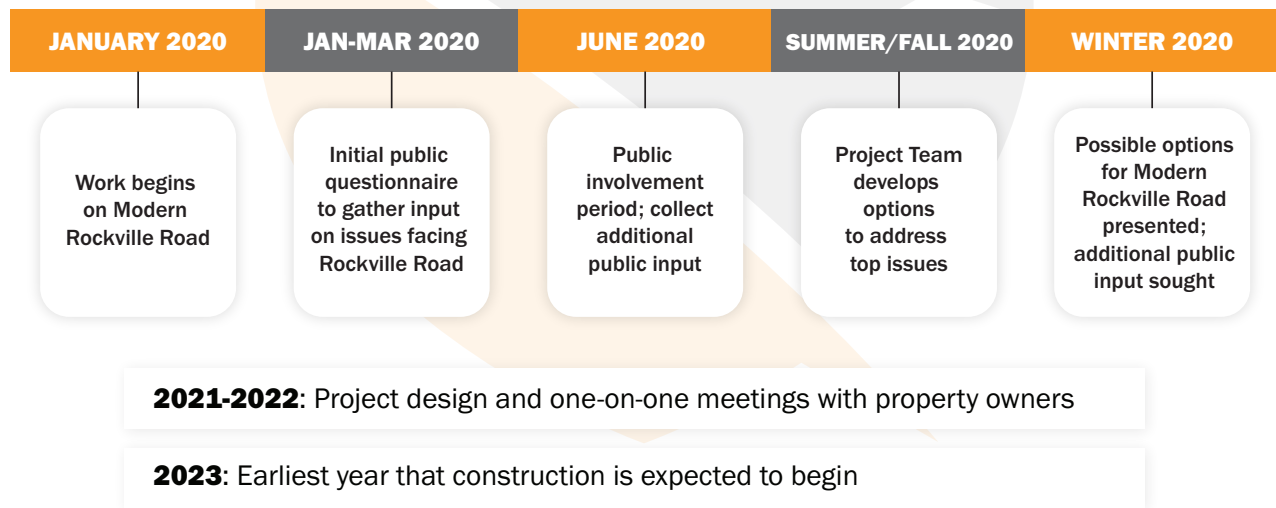
The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) has launched the Modern Rockville Road project to gather information about nearly three miles of U.S. 36/Rockville Road between Raceway Road and I-465.

The information gathered, including public input, will help the Project Team prioritize issues facing the corridor and identify next steps.

ABOUT MODERN ROCKVILLE ROAD

- ▶ INDOT is considering improvements to nearly three miles of U.S. 36/Rockville Road west of I-465 in Marion County.
- ▶ This section of Rockville Road is five lanes, two in each direction and a center turn lane, with paved shoulders.
- ▶ The Project Team will recommend possible improvements for public input.

TIMELINE



ALONG THE ROADWAY



This section of Rockville Road is lined by both homes and businesses.



There are about 200 unique land parcels with frontage along Rockville Road and the city streets that intersect it.



Surveyors estimate there are 37 linear miles of service lines operated by 15 different utilities.

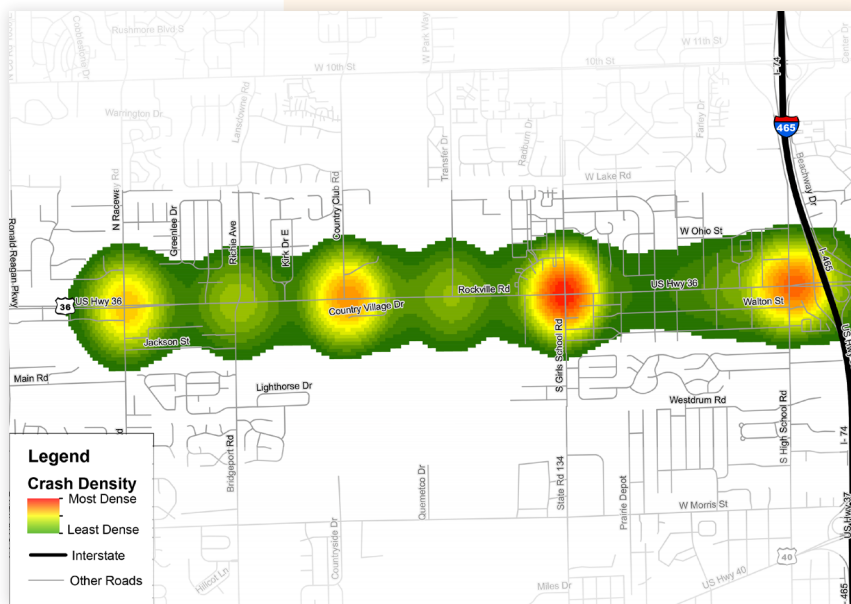

According to INDOT's traffic count database, traffic near Country Club Road has stayed consistent from 2016-2019, but traffic elsewhere along the corridor is up from 9 to 25 percent. The most significant increases are just west of Girls School Road and High School Road.

CRASH HISTORY: 2016 to 2018




The Rockville Road intersection with Girls School Road is in the top 1% for crash ratings in the state when compared to similar intersections. The intersection at High School Road is in top 5% for crashes when looking at the frequency of crashes. The number of crashes near the traffic signals at the Country Club Road and Transfer Drive intersections and the business driveways in between are also higher than expected.

NEXT STEPS

- ▶ There are several opportunities for public input as part of project development.
- ▶ Motorists, and members of the public are invited to watch a short video, review project information and complete an online questionnaire. Responses will be accepted through June 30.
- ▶ Questionnaire responses will inform the planning work to occur this year.
- ▶ The Project Team will recommend Rockville Road improvements later this year and ask again for your feedback.
